By hosting YMHA interns, you're providing meaningful learning experiences while helping to build a more inclusive and culturally responsive mental health workforce.

INTERNSHIP DETAILS

- 80+ hours over 5 to 7 weeks
- Between mid-June to mid-August 2026
- In-person, hybrid, or remote
- YMHA pays interns a stipend up to \$2,000
- YMHA provides support to interns and hosts

- Primarily 16 to 19 years old
- Located across California
- Completed the Youth Mental Health Academy summer program
- Received Adolescent Crisis Response training
